## 2000-2010

Conducting both international and local training courses, and implementing collaborative international exchange projects

- **2000** The Land Reform Training Institute was renamed on January 1, 2000 as International Center for Land Policy Studies and Training (ICLPST).
- **2001** Twenty-two sessions of the Training Project for Agricultural Seed Extension Workers were conducted. A total of 757 ROC local agricultural officials and extension workers participated.
- In line with the government's policy of "Shortening Digital Gap" and "Farmers' Continuation Education Program", the ICLPST was designated as "Rural Development and Team Work Education Center" for the northern area of Taiwan.
- **2005** The ICLPST was officially recognized by the Council of Agriculture as an agricultural education and training institute.
- 2006 A series of events for Celebrating ICLPST's 100 Regular Sessions were held. The events included the International Conference-Toward A 2015 Vision of Land, in which 22 papers were presented, International Field Day, Celebration Ceremony, Exposition of Paintings of Rural Communities through the Eyes of Children and other international publicities. More than 500 persons from over 40 countries participated.

Training Seminar for middle and high ranking officials and technicians of Saudi Arabian Ministry of Agriculture was planned and conducted for the first time. Since then, the Ministry kept commissioning the ICLPST with various training projects on themes expanded to agriculture, forestry, fishery, and husbandry.

2008 A celebration of the 40th anniversary and the joint commencement ceremony of the 106th and 107th Regular Sessions were held.
